## Dufferin through the seasons



Avg. Temp: -10° to 0°C (plus windchill) | Regular snowfall  
Snow-covered landscapes invite skiing, snowshoeing, and fat tire biking.



Avg. Temp: 5° to 15°C | Moderate rainfall  
Fresh blooms and mild days make spring ideal for hiking and nature walks.



Avg. Temp: 20° to 28°C | Occasional rainfall  
Warm, sunny days are perfect for outdoor festivals, trails, and patio season.



Avg. Temp: 8° to 18°C | Light to moderate rainfall  
Cooler air and vibrant fall colours set the stage for scenic drives, harvest experiences, and cozy escapes.

## Getting here

Dufferin County is conveniently located in south-central Ontario, making it an easy and rewarding escape from many of the province's major urban centres. Just over an hour northwest of Toronto, the county is within comfortable driving distance of the GTA, Peel Region, Waterloo Region, and Simcoe County. With well-connected highways and scenic country roads leading the way, getting to Dufferin County is as enjoyable as the time you'll spend once you arrive.

### From Toronto

From the south, take Hurontario Street (Hwy 10) north, or from the east take Hwy 400 north and exit at Hwy 9 to Orangeville.

### From Waterloo

Take Hwy 7 or 8 east to Hwy 3.

### From Owen Sound

Take Hwy 10 south through Shelburne.

### From Collingwood

Take Hwy 124 or Airport Road south to Hwy 89.

### From Alliston

Take Hwy 89 or County roads west.



Pearson International Airport is just an hour away, with regional options like Waterloo and Billy Bishop also nearby. Dufferin's prime location makes commuting and travel seamless.

### 6 Mono

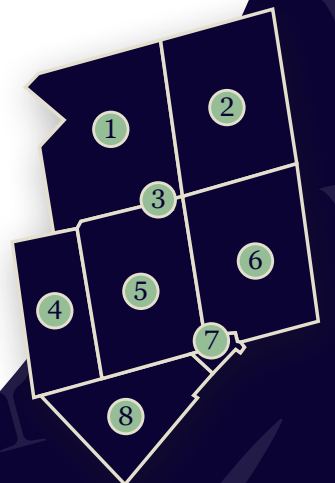

**Mono Cliffs Provincial Park**  
Enjoy multiple hiking/biking trails, lookout points, ponds, crevice caves, 30 metre cliffs, huge prominent rock masses, and is accessible for all ages!

**Luther Marsh Wildlife Management Area**  
One of Ontario's best bird-watching spots. A 5,900-hectare property centers on the 1,400-hectare Luther Lake.

**Upper Grand Trailway**  
Volunteers maintain this 10.5 km trail on the old CPR line. Resurfaced for hikers, cyclists, cross country skiers and horseback riders.

**Monora Park**  
A 40-acre natural park, with 18 kms of walking and x-country ski trails, a picnic shelter, gazebo, an open playing field.



**Hockley Valley Nature Reserve**  
Moderate-level trails lined with trilliums in early summer. Or snowshoe the reserve in winter. No biking permitted.



**Island Lake Conservation Area**  
Connect with nature and explore 820 acres of lake, wetland and forests. Open year round.



**Dufferin County Forest**  
One of southern Ontario's largest unbroken forest areas totaling over 600 hectares (1,400 acres).

**Pine River Provincial Fishing Area**  
Often frequented for its populations of trout, particularly brook trout and brown trout, making it an attractive destination for fly fishing enthusiasts.

**Dufferin County Forest**

**Dufferin Rail Trail**  
The 38.1 km Dufferin portion of the former rail corridor runs from Orangeville to Dundalk. This is an unmaintained trail.

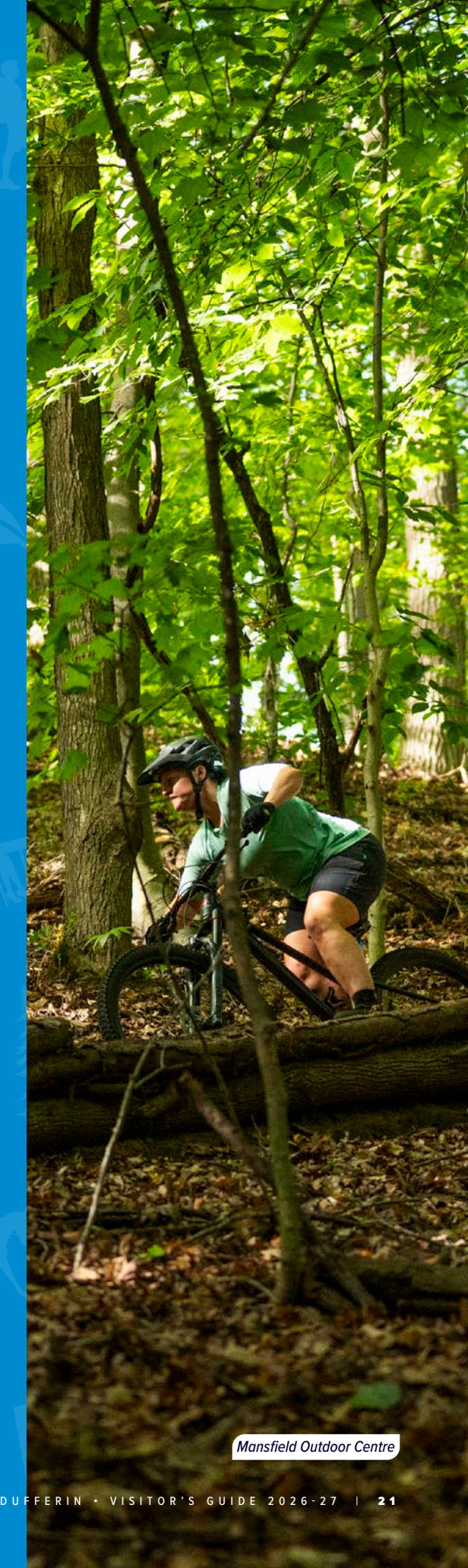

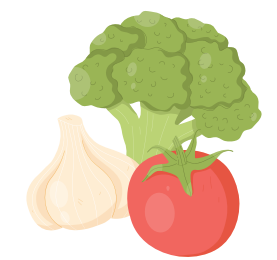
