Dufferin County Takes Part in Ontario Renovates Program

Through the Ontario Renovates Component of the Investment in Affordable Housing Program (IAH), the County of Dufferin provides up to \$3,500 in grant assistance to eligible applicants.

The Ontario Renovates Program launched this summer and is designed to provide low to moderate income homeowners, or renters, with financial assistance towards home renovations or upgrades needed to make their house accessible.

The Program Criteria is:

- Applicants must be at least eighteen (18) years old
- Renters must obtain written permission from the Landlord
- Have a gross household income at or below **\$82,600***
- The current value of the home must be at or below **\$366,655****
- Maximum grant is **\$3,500**
