Council approved the 2013 budget. In 2013, the 7.99% increase will come : 0.72% from new Growth and 7.27% Tax increase

COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION TO SAVE THE STANTON HOTEL

Mr. Carl Tafel provided Council with an update on the successful fundraising events recently held for the proposed relocation of the former Stanton Hotel.

JEAN HAMLYN DAY CARE CENTRE

Along with a 10% increase in fees beginning in February 2013, Council directed staff to investigate the following in efforts to continue addressing ongoing sustainability of Jean Hamlyn.

1. Investigate the possibility of relocation of the centre to a local school
2. Investigate the possibility of offering summer camps
3. Investigate the expansion of toddler care
4. Investigate the possibility of infant care at a rate reflective of the cost of care
5. Investigate the possibilities of hiring ECE assistants
6. Investigate the possibility of resuming the parent advisory committee

PROCEDURAL BY-LAW REVIEW

A procedural by-law is a legislative requirement under the *Municipal Act, 2001* and governs the calling, place and proceedings of meetings of Council. The current County procedural by-law was passed in 2008 and it is good practice to review this by-law every few years. Council has directed General Government Services Committee and appropriate staff to conduct a comprehensive review of the by-law to ensure current procedures are efficient and to consider where new procedures or changes should be included.
