

**PRESENTATION – HEADWATERS HEALTH CARE CENTRE**

Ms. Liz Ruegg, President and CEO of Headwaters Health Care Centre addressed Council and provided an update on hospital activities. She stated that there has been a decline in patients admitted to hospital but emergency visits and outpatients are increasing. The focus on care in the future will be to keep people in their homes as long as possible.

**STATEMENT OF THE TREASURER – REMUNERATION AND EXPENSES**

As required by Section 284 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, the Statement of the Treasurer of the Remuneration and Expenses paid to members of Council, and to persons appointed to serve on local boards, for the year 2012 was presented to Council.

**SHELBURNE AFFORDABLE HOUSING DRAWINGS**

The Community Services Dufferin Oaks committee convened at the former Shelburne Hospital site at its meeting held on February 28, 2013 to review drawings prepared by Mr. Mark Hicks, Dickinson and Hicks Architects Inc., for the proposed conversion to affordable housing units. The plans consist of proposed changes to the exterior of the building and the creation of 24 apartments. There is also approximately 3,000 square feet that could be used for commercial purposes or also be converted in the residential units. Mr. Hicks reported that they are working on a budget presently.

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## FORMER STANTON HOTEL UPDATE

An interim staff report regarding the former Stanton Hotel was presented at the Museum Board meeting held on March 6, 2013. The report provided information, while also highlighting items and issues of additional consideration with respect to the following:

Council directed staff to collaborate with the Community Association to Save the Stanton Hotel (CASSH) to compile the financial information pertaining to the costs of moving, rehabilitating and operating the building and asked that a final report be prepared for the next meeting of the Museum Board.
