### **FIRST AVENUE APARTMENTS IN SHELBURNE CONTRACT AWARDED**



Council awarded a construction tender for the conversion of the former Shelburne Hospital to affordable apartments for seniors and disabled. There will be 24 apartments in total. Ten of the 24 units are affordable. The project budget is \$4.5 Million and the completion date is slated for the summer of 2014.

The successful bidder was Bertram Construction.

Council agreed to share in the cost with the Citizens Association to Save the Stanton Hotel (CASSH) of the moving the former Stanton Hotel from the corner of 5<sup>th</sup> Sideroad and Airport Road in Mulmur to the Museum. ## CLEAR BAG WASTE POLICY



Council approved an adjustment to the clear bag garbage policy that commences on June 1<sup>st</sup>.

Residents in Dufferin County will be permitted to place up to two privacy bags in the clear bags and an application process will be developed for those who need additional privacy bags. Also, the size of the privacy bags were increased to 20x22 inches.

## PLANNING FOR COUNTY-WIDE OFFICIAL PLAN

A group of local CAO's and Planners will participate in a staff working group for the County Official Plan Process. The Official Plan is mandated by the Province and will be completed by 2015.

## TOLL ROAD IN MARSVILLE – LABOUR DAY

Council approved a request of Marsville Lions Club to have a toll road for charity on Labour Day Monday from 1pm to 4pm. They will be asking motorists for loose change to raise money for community projects.

## GATES GOING UP ON FORMER RAIL LINE NORTH OF SHELBURNE

Approximately 15 gates will be purchased for the rail line, north of Shelburne to prevent motorists having vehicles larger than an ATV on the land. Emergency services will be provided keys to the gates. Staff were directed to prepare an emergency plan for those using the former rail corridor.
