

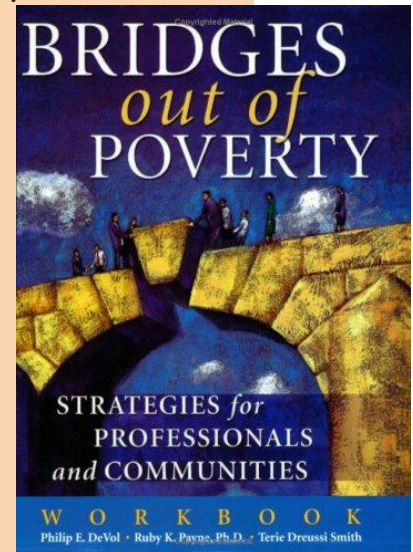
Bridges out of Poverty
