ROADS UPDATE #4– DUFFERIN COUNTY

Update: 1:30 p.m.

Emergency Services and municipal staff had a conference call at 1:00 p.m. Several Roads in Dufferin County remain closed from last evening due to blowing snow. Shelters were established at the Centre Dufferin Recreation Complex and the Honeywood Arena and housed 420 guests. Also, handful of people stayed over night at the County of Dufferin offices at 30 Centre Street, Orangeville.

Dufferin OPP are currently assessing the roads and will provide updates as they become available.

CLOSURES

- CR#124 north of 89 CLOSED likely for a long period of time
- Hwy 89 east of Shelburne is OPEN
- Hwy 89 west of Shelburne CLOSED
- Hwy 10 open south of Shelburne to let stranded southbound motorists travel only – Hwy 10 northbound from Orangeville CLOSED
- County Roads 11, 12, 19 CLOSED
- encouraging folks to vacate shelters if they are able
- 80 people remain in the Shelter in Shelburne
- most of the abandoned vehicles have been removed from the roads
- Roads remain closed
- Roads crews are working with the OPP to retrieve stranded motorists

The public is asked to stay off these roads so our crews can get the snow drifts removed.
