### **FREE ICE STORM DEBRIS DROP-OFF EXTENDED TO APRIL 30**

Dufferin County has extended the deadline for residents to bring ice storm debris to the GFL Dufferin Transfer Station until Saturday, April 30<sup>th</sup>. Up until this date, branches and brush brought down by the ice storm will be accepted free of charge for residents who provide photo ID with a Dufferin County address. The Transfer Station is located at 473051 Dufferin Road 11, Amaranth and is open Monday to Friday 7am to 5pm and Saturday 7am to 3pm.

Residents are also reminded that the County's regular yard waste collection program has begun. Visit [dufferincounty.ca/waste](http://dufferincounty.ca/waste) for the yard waste schedule and collection areas or contact DufferinWaste at 519.941.2816 ext. 2620. Yard waste set out to the curb for this collection must be no longer than 1.25m (4 feet) in length, and in bundles no heavier than 20kg (44lbs).

Residents should contact their local municipality or visit local municipal websites for specific information on how each municipality is addressing clean-up of branches and brush brought down by the ice storm.
