Mr. Bob Shirley, Chair of Friends of Island Lake addressed Council with respect to an update on the status of the Island Lake Community Trails Campaign at Island Lake Conservation Area. They are currently fundraising to connect the

north and south trails with a series of boardwalks that will cost approximately \$500 000 to \$600 000. He noted they had entered into the Shell Oil program and won \$10 000 in the first round and are now entered to try and win \$50 000.

Mr. Shirley thanked Council for their past support and said they will be requesting another \$25 000 again in 2012.
