Subject: Interim Waste Collection Agreements

PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to get approval from the Committee and Council for the execution of an agreement with the two current waste collection companies for the collection and disposal of waste, recycling and compost for an interim period from January 1, 2013 to May 31, 2013.

BACKGROUND and DISCUSSION

Staff was "directed to work with the local municipalities and waste contractors to have the current collection contracts extended to May 31, 2013". Staff has received the existing contracts and agreements from the local municipalities and are in the process of creating two agreements to have Green for Life Environmental and Waste Management continue to collect the waste from the various local municipalities for the first five months of 2013.

Staff has been in discussions with out solicitors to develop a "short" agreement that would append the existing contracts/agreements for the detail as to how the collection and disposal will continue. The body of the new agreement would include any changes that are anticipated, i.e. we do not need seven different fuel surcharge methods when one will do.

Chair Taylor and the Director offered to meet with those municipalities that had landfill sites to discuss what their preference was for disposal. Meetings were arranged with the Townships of Mulmur and Amaranth to discuss their preferences. Staff has received confirmation that Amaranth, Mono and Mulmur will not be accepting the collected waste at their landfill sites. Arrangements will be made in this agreement for the disposal of the waste collected.

It was hoped that a draft of the agreement would be available prior to the distribution of the agenda, but unfortunately that is not the case. A copy will be distributed at the meeting.

LOCAL MUNICIPAL IMPACT

All local municipalities have been involved in the process.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The 2013 operating budget projection presented with the 2012 operating budget included the cost of collection for the whole County. By the time the 2013 operating budget is passed, we will have a better idea as to the total cost based on the interim collection agreements and the recently closed RFP for collection and disposal county-wide. The County will be assuming the costs for the local contracts effective January 1, 2013. The landfill costs in Melancthon will be assumed by the County for the first five months of 2013.

Recommendation

The County of Dufferin is initiating a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study for the above noted area. GENIVAR Inc. (GENIVAR) has been retained to carry out the study, on behalf of the County. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the study and invite your input.

The goal of the study is to complete the Class EA in order to review and evaluate current and future levels of service at the intersection of Highway 89 at Amaranth-East Luther Townline Road in the interest of identifying any problems and opportunities to recommend a solution to improve intersection operations. This project will be completed as a Schedule "B" Environmental Assessment in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Engineers Association document "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, October 2000, as amended in 2007 & 2011".

The study will:

- identify problems and opportunities for improvement; and
- recommend a solution through a comprehensive and environmentally sound planning process with public participation.

A key component of the study is providing information and obtaining input from stakeholders. This is achieved through a consultation program which will include development of a newsletter that will be released to stakeholders to provide environmental information on the project.

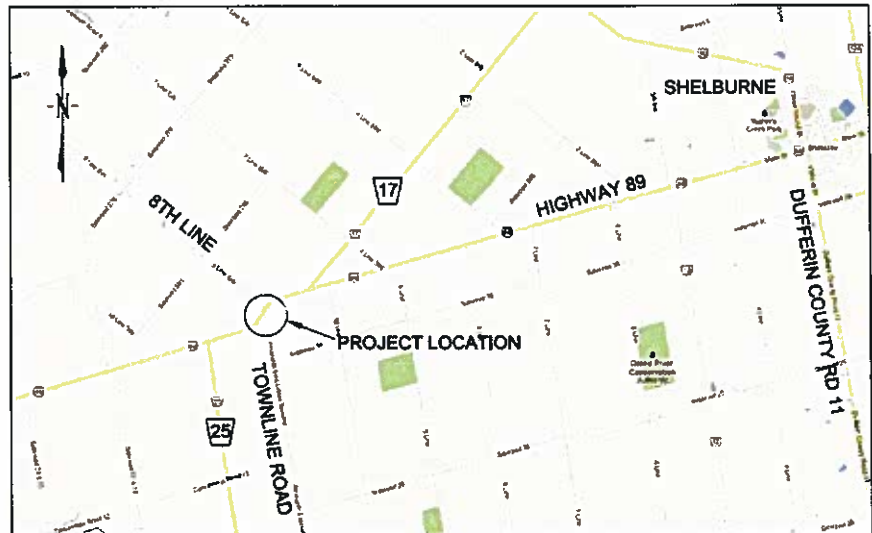
NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT

MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY FOR INTERSECTION OF HIGHWAY 89 AND AMARANTH-EAST LUTHER TOWNLINER ROAD

The County of Dufferin has initiated a Schedule 'B' Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to investigate improvements to the intersection of Highway 89 and Amaranth-East Luther Townline Road. The approximate limits of the project study area are illustrated on the enclosed map.

Highway 89 and Amaranth-East Luther Townline Road is currently an off-set intersection with no auxiliary lanes. Planning related to the Dufferin Eco-Energy Park (DEEP) has identified the need for re-alignment of the intersection to eliminate the offset intersection and the provision of a westbound left turn lane on Highway 89, to accommodate future anticipated traffic demands.

The study will review and evaluate current and future level of service at the intersection of Highway 89 and Townline Road in order to identify the problems and opportunities and recommend a strategy to improve intersection operations.



The Process

The study is being conducted in accordance with the approved requirements for a Schedule 'B' project as described in the Municipal Engineers Association's Municipal Class EA document (October 2000, as amended in 2007). The Class EA process will include public review and agency consultation, an evaluation of intersection improvement alternatives and selection of the preferred solution, taking into account public and agency input.

Public Consultation

Public consultation is key to the success of this study. We want to ensure that anyone interested in this study has the opportunity to get involved and provide input. The County plans to release a newsletter to provide background information on the Study, comparative analysis of various alternative solutions and selection of the technically preferred solution. Upon completion of the study, an Environmental Assessment Summary Document will be submitted to the Ministry of the Environment and other key agencies and made available for public review for a period of 30 days. Subject to comments received and the receipt of necessary approvals, the County intends to proceed with the detailed design and construction of this project.
