Propane tanks	HHW Days (Dufferin Transfer is being investigated as a location.)
Tires	Most tire dealers or Dufferin Transfer
Bale wrap	Dufferin Transfer
Construction Waste	Dufferin Transfer
White Goods	Any metal recycler or Dufferin Transfer

5. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE – August 23, 2012 – Item #5 Draft Waste Management Collection By-Law

A report from the Director of Public Works dated August 23, 2012 to present the Committee with a draft Waste Collection By-law. The Committee reviewed the draft by-law and made the following comments:

*Section 1(1) (o) – Dwelling Unit – look at the word purpose
(mm) – Refuse Constituting a Public Nuisance” – add the word “rodent”*

Section 3(1) – time should be 7 a.m.

*Section 5 (a) (vii) – remove words “and bag”
(b) (vii) – remove words “container and”
(d) – clarify the amount
(j) – needs to move up to Section 5 (c)*

Section 6 (3) (b) – need to check with GFL

Section 9 (6) (a) & (b) – should be put into a schedule

Section 17 – needs to be re-worded

Section 26 – should be more progressive enforcement

Schedule D – staff was asked to report back to the next meeting if plastic bags, plastic grocery sacks, polystyrene and Styrofoam packaging and food and beverage containers will be acceptable recyclable materials.

Staff will incorporate the Committee and solicitors comments and report back to committee.

World's Largest Energy-from-Waste Plant
