Capital Budget

Remove \$600,000 from the capital project (CD Waste 1007) and move to the Public Works budget.

Operating Budget

Reduce Household Hazardous Waste Contracts (H13-38012-00-3100) by \$20,000
Reduce Household Hazardous Waste Revenue (H13-38012-00-8250) by \$5,000

Add to the Curbside Collections (13-38016-00-3100), Vacuum Lead Service (13-38016-00-3102) and Green Bin Collections (13-38016-00-3101) \$193,000

Bale Wrap, Polystyrene Foam and Plastics Collection

Chris Fast gave a verbal update with respect to a bale wrap and plastics collection. He noted that staff had attended a tour of the recycling facility in Cambridge and discussed polystyrene foam, plastic grocery sacks and small plastic bags as acceptable recyclable materials. Staff is waiting for a figure on how much additional charge there would be to include these plastics in the recycling program.

The Director of Public Works informed the Committee that Switch Energy Corp. has a current program to recycle bale wrap that Dufferin residents can use. The County will promote this service to its residents.
