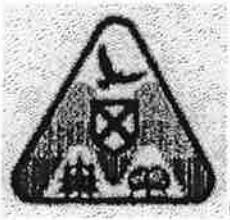

# Corporation of the Township of MULMUR

Moved by: Campbell Moon

Date: June 5, 2013

THAT WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Mulmur conditionally consented to the County of Dufferin assuming waste management by Motion #227-10, June 23, 2010 and Motion #303-10, September 07, 2010;

AND WHEREAS, the County of Dufferin has not met the following conditions of the motions:

- The County of Dufferin did not implement a fair system of costing and the Township of Mulmur ratepayer's waste management fee is exorbitantly higher than before the County's assumption of waste,
- It appears that Dufferin Eco Energy Park (DEEP) will not be in operation by December 31, 2014,
- The Eco Premium is not capped at 10% over commercial rates for the Township of Mulmur;

AND WHEREAS, the County of Dufferin passed By-Law Number 2010-29, September 16, 2010, which confirms that the County of Dufferin was looking for alternative methods of solid waste treatment;

AND WHEREAS, the County of Dufferin was developing the DEEP to utilize these methods of treatment;

AND WHEREAS, the County of Dufferin identified the need to control the waste stream to secure tipping fees that would be competitive with current commercial rates;

AND WHEREAS, the County of Dufferin stated that a coordinated waste system in the County would allow for a greater opportunity for effective promotion/education, diversion and cost savings;

AND WHEREAS, the County of the Township of Mulmur would not have consulted to the County of Dufferin's assumption of waste without these conditions;

THEREFORE, Mulmur Council respectfully requests that the Corporation of the Township of Mulmur be removed from the County of Dufferin's assumption of waste program and that the levy be revised to reflect same.
