To Whom It May Concern:

On Sunday, October 21st the Town of Mono is pleased to be hosting a new gravel grinder biking event in the Town of Mono, the Howling Coyote. Cyclists will be able to choose from a 20 km, 40 km or 80 km bike ride/race through the picturesque hills of Mono focusing on routes on Mono's gravel roads, road allowances and trails. As part of the route, the ride will travel through 2 km's of the Mono Tract in the County forest from the Hurontario north entrance to the 1st line on the north side.

It is our understanding that in order to ride the Mono Tract there is a \$56.50 administration fee payable to the County plus \$2.00 per rider. As the event is expected to attract 200 – 250 riders and as we will only be using two km's of trail through the County forest, (our expectation is that it will take less than five minutes for the riders to complete this section of the ride) I would like to request that the \$2.00 per rider fee be waived.
