-  Nominee works directly with staff and/or children
-  Nominee must agree to be nominated

How Recipients are Chosen:

A committee of professionals in the Early Childhood Education field in the County of Dufferin selects the award recipients. The committee makes its selections based on the submitted nomination package only and uses a pre-determined set of selection criteria.

The nominee:

- 🌱 Provides environments that respect and support inclusion, meaningful participation, and a sense of belonging for all children
- 🌱 Shows concern for children's sense of self, health and well-being
- 🌱 Values a connection with each child and recognizing and valuing his or her unique spirit, individuality, and presence
- 🌱 Is attuned to the physical and emotional states of each child and responding in a sensitive matter
- 🌱 Cultivates caring relationships and connections among and between children, adults, and the world around them

Assembling a Nomination Package:

An effective nomination will illustrate the outstanding achievements of the nominee and will clearly explain why they should receive this award

- 🌱 The text of the nomination should be a maximum of two pages in length. Please use concrete examples
- 🌱 Letters of support may be included but are not required
- 🌱 The candidate's College of ECE membership number must be included

Presentation of Award:

The award recipient will receive a certificate at the Raising the Bar - Dufferin County Early Learning Celebration.
