Dufferin County Community Support Services (DCCSS) is a not-for-profit agency funded by the Central West Local Health Integration Network and operated by the County of Dufferin. The office is located in the Mel Lloyd Centre in the Town of Shelburne and provides services such as Transportation, Meals on Wheels, Friendly Visiting and Home Respite, which aim to assist older and vulnerable adults who live independently in their own homes.

Casual transportation drivers will drive agency vehicles to transport clients to and from medical related appointments as requested.

To meet the requirements of this position, the successful candidate will have the following:

- Valid class G driver's licence.
- Valid personal automobile insurance – minimum \$1,000,000 liability.
- Clean and recent driver's abstract.
- Be sensitive to needs of seniors and physically disabled.
- Be physically able to assist clients in and out of a vehicle, folding wheelchairs and walkers as necessary
- Hours will vary depending on transportation requests. May include evenings and weekends.
- Must be willing to drive throughout the Greater Toronto Area, including the downtown core of Toronto.
