Fee Subsidy

The County of Dufferin provides a Child Care Fee Subsidy to eligible families within Dufferin County. Child Care Fee Subsidy is for children 0 - 12 years of age, enrolled in an authorized program.

Eligible situations: Parents/Guardians must be working, or attending education/training, or fulfilling a participation agreement with Ontario Works, or be in receipt of a referral from a Community Agency or appropriate medical professional. Eligibility for Child Care Fee Subsidy is based on both income and eligible hours of care.

The Income Test is based on the income of the applicant as reported on their Canada Revenue Agency Notice of Assessment. Assets, debts and living expenses are not considered under the Income Test.

Jean Hamlyn Day Care Centre

Jean Hamlyn Day Care Centre is a child care centre, owned and operated by the County of Dufferin. It is licensed by the Ministry of Education for a capacity of 65 children. Program staff are registered with the College of Early Childhood Educators.

At Jean Hamlyn Day Care Centre, all programs focus on viewing children as competent, capable, curious and rich in potential and provide them with learning opportunities based on their interests. They explore and practice these attributes through play. When children are playing, they are learning!

- Pre-school Program (children ages 2.5 - 4)
Full and Part time
- Early Learning Program (children ages 2.5 - 4)
9:00am to 11:30am (Tuesdays and Thursdays)
- Before and After School Program for Kindergarten and School Age (children ages 4-12) Full and Part time

Programs are age-appropriate, and include fine and gross motor activities, dramatic and creative centers, reading and early literacy activities, and outdoor play.
