The County itself sits on the fringe of the Greater Toronto Area, about 100 kilometres northwest of Toronto. It is largely a rural County with three urban settlement areas. The UNESCO World Biosphere Reserve, the Niagara Escarpment and the world famous Bruce Trail, run through Dufferin offering spectacular vistas and hiking opportunities. Dufferin Oaks provides accommodation, meals, supportive services, socialization and a full range of nursing care services for persons who, for various reasons, cannot live independently in the community.

We are currently recruiting for caring and compassionate part time Registered Practical Nurses. These positions are responsible for the care of residents in their assigned Home area and provide supervision to the Personal Support Workers.

In order to be successful in this role, you will need:

- Current registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario (C.N.O.).
- Effective oral and written communication skills.
- Minimum one (1) year experience in a hospital or long term care home setting.
- Working knowledge of the use of computers.
- Gerontology certificate or related courses considered an asset.
