We are set to resume our **FROZEN** Meals on Wheels Program effective April 7<sup>th</sup>, for food delivery on April 15-16<sup>th</sup>. We are contacting our clients who have placed orders prior to the suspension of the program. We will be resuming our regular schedule for ordering and deliveries. Please see the attached schedule for future dates.

Our **Hot Meals** programs in Orangeville and Shelburne will resume service the first week of May. Staff will be in contact with those clients to advise and to ensure all orders are completed accurately.

County of Dufferin Community Support Services Staff or designated County of Dufferin Staff will be delivering the meals to our clients. We will be advising our clients of the drop off process to ensure physical distancing and will ensure that clients accept the food deliveries in a safe manner. Staff will assist clients who may require additional support with the deliveries.

Our Adult Day Program, Medical Transportation program, Bathing program and Congregate Dining Program continue to be suspended indefinitely. Only essential Medical Transportation will continue.

Our office is still available to support you during this time of great uncertainty. If you have any concerns about access to food, or other essentials, please call us. We will do our best to support your needs where we can, or connect with other community resources to assist you. We will manage this support directly with you.
