<b>ISOLATION REQUIREMENTS</b>	<b>CLOSE CONTACT</b> – only residents with positive room mates are required to isolate. If a resident has a close contact with a visitor or when on an outing, please ensure resident is screened twice per day. Resident to be isolate immediately if symptoms develop			
	<b>SYMPTOMATIC</b> - Resident is to be isolated and tested. If negative, follow usual isolation requirements for respiratory and/or enteric illnesses. If positive for COVID, resident is to isolate for 10 days from start of symptoms. Roommate is to isolate until a negative result is obtained from day five PCR test.
