

Cleaning and disinfecting after a worker is symptomatic or has been confirmed positive for COVID-19

For one worker showing symptoms or testing positive:

- Immediately isolate the worker in their own bedroom or other designated space.
- Clean and disinfect all common areas the worker has been in and all surfaces the worker may have handled or touched as soon as you are aware of symptoms beginning. Follow the cleaning and disinfecting instructions on the Enhanced Cleaning Procedures.
- Provide the worker with cleaning and disinfecting products to clean their own room and washroom on a daily basis. The worker can do this on their own. If the workers symptoms are too severe to clean their own space, contact your local health authority for advice.
- Arrange food to be delivered and waste to be collected to the door of the isolated worker.
- Ensure workers picking up waste and used dishes have gloves / mask and instructions to wash hands immediately after.

For two or more workers showing symptoms or testing positive:

- Immediately isolate the workers in their own bedroom or other designated space.
- Immediately contact your local Health Authority.
- Follow the direction of the local Health Authority.
- Clean and disinfect all common areas the workers have been in and all surfaces the workers may have handled or touched as soon as you are aware of symptoms beginning. Follow the cleaning and disinfecting instructions on the Enhanced Cleaning Procedures document.

If symptoms worsen or if there is a medical emergency, call 911 and advise the ambulance services that there is a known or suspected COVID-19 case at your location.

Ensure any isolated workers continue to complete a self assessment daily to monitor for changes in symptoms.
