

COVID-19 Worker Self Isolation Protocol

In the event that a worker has a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19 our farm has implemented the following provisions for worker self-isolation:

- If an employee has common cold or influenza like illness or symptoms compatible with COVID-19 they must self-isolate at home for a **minimum** of 10 days from symptom onset AND ensure their symptoms, including fever, have completely resolved.
- If an employee has common cold or influenza like illness or symptoms compatible with COVID-19 (fever, cough, shortness of breath) and are hospitalized, or the employee is identified by public health as a person who is part of a cluster or outbreak, arrangements will be made for a COVID-19 test: If an employee tests positive for COVID-19, they must self-isolate on site or in separate accommodations/hotel for a **minimum** of 10 days from symptom onset AND ensure their symptoms, including fever, have completely resolved.
- If an employee tests negative for COVID-19, they must self-isolate at home or in separate accommodations/hotel until their common cold or influenza like symptoms have completely resolve
- We will ensure workers adhere to physician’s advice and current BC Center for Disease Control guidelines
- We will report the case to WorkSafeBC if it is believed it’s a workplace acquired infection. This claim report will be subject to WorkSafeBC’s review
- We will identify and isolate any areas that may have been contaminated by the infected worker. The identified work area will be cleaned and disinfected as per COVID-19 disinfection guidelines
