Land Acknowledgement Statement

HOMEOWNERSHIP

The County of Dufferin's Home Ownership Program is designed to provide moderate income households with an interest free down payment assistance loan/second mortgage to help purchase a home.

There are no monthly mortgage payments, repayment is only required when the property is sold or terms of the loan are not fulfilled (loan amount and % of capital gain) and the full amount is forgivable after 20 years if the house is not resold.

The County of Dufferin can provide up to ten percent (10%) of the purchase price of the home to a maximum of \$60,911.



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ONTARIO RENOVATES

An objective of the Ontario Renovates component is to foster independent living of seniors and persons with disabilities by providing financial assistance to support modifications and renovations to increase accessibility of affordable rental and ownership properties.
