2015 Report Card

In 2015, through partnerships and collaboration...





The County began construction of three additional affordable housing units within 301 First Avenue East in Shelburne. Completion in 2016.



Over 350 families with more than 550 children received assistance with purchasing nutritious food, educational supplies and winter clothing through programming to address poverty.





The County helped 11 households purchase a home through Homeownership down payment assistance loans.

41 households were provided with housing from the Centralized Waiting List for rentgeared-to-income assistance.







New partnership developed with Headwaters Communities in Action and Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph Public Health to co-host the 2015 Poverty and Housing forum with the County.

The County helped 346 households obtain or maintain their housing through the Homelessness Prevention Program (HPP), and began working on the new Ontario Electricity Support Program.
