2016 Report Card

In 2016, through partnerships and collaboration...



The County approved a new development of 24 housing units. The new development will offer "Affordable" and "Rent Geared to Income" units at 54 Lawrence Ave. Orangeville. The project is scheduled for completion in 2018.

The County as the Community Entity for the Dufferin Community Advisory Board (CAB) joined the 20,000 Homes campaign and conducted a 48 hour count of chronic and episodically homeless within Dufferin County.





36 households were provided with housing from the Centralized Waiting List for rent -geared-to-income assistance.

The County assisted 2 households with renovations geared to accessibility through the Ontario Renovates Program.





The County helped 9 households purchase a home through Homeownership down payment assistance loans.

The County helped 529 households obtain or maintain their housing through the Homelessness Prevention Program (HPP).
